Letter dated 8 October 1979 from the Permanent Representative of  
the Dominican Republic to the United Nations addressed to the  
Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit to you herewith the report on the effects of hurricanes "David" and "Frederic" on the Dominican Republic prepared by a group of experts of the Economic Commission for Latin America (ECLA) 1/ at the request of the Dominican Government.

This report also indicates the basic requirements for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of the Dominican Republic and identifies a number of programmes and projects for which international assistance may be needed; it also indicates the area in which programmes of the United Nations and the specialized agencies could provide useful assistance.

Inasmuch as the General Assembly decided to take up under agenda item 125 the question of measures to assist the Dominican Republic following the severe disasters caused by hurricane "David" and hurricane "Frederic" and to allocate the item to the Second Committee, I should be grateful if you would have the above-mentioned report circulated as a General Assembly document.
