Letter dated 29 October 1979 from the Permanent Representative of
Barbados to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit to you, on instructions, herewith the report on the effects of hurricane "David" on the Commonwealth of Dominica, E/CEPAL/PLEN.13/G2, prepared by a group of experts of the Economic Commission for Latin America.

The report also indicates the basic requirements for rehabilitation and reconstruction of the Commonwealth of Dominica and identifies a number of areas for which international assistance will be needed.

Inasmuch as the General Assembly has decided to consider under agenda item 125, the question of measures to assist the Commonwealth of Dominica following the severe disaster caused by hurricane "David" and to allocate the item to the Second Committee, I would be grateful if you would have the above-mentioned report circulated as a General Assembly document.
