The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 3201 (S-VI) and 3202 (S-VI) of 1 May 1974,
containing the Declaration and the Programme of Action on the Establishment of a
New International Economic Order,

Recalling also its resolution 3281 (XXIX) of 12 December 1974, containing the
Charter of Economic Rights and Duties of States,

Considering its resolution 3362 (S-VII) of 16 September 1975, which set in
motion measures that form the basis and framework for the work of the competent
bodies and organizations of the United Nations system,

Recalling further its resolution 33/20 of 29 November 1978 on the United
Nations Institute for Training and Research,

Acknowledging the value of the research and "futures studies" undertaken by
the United Nations Institute for Training and Research,

Recognizing the role of the United Nations Institute for Training and
Research in assisting, through training and other services within its mandate,
members of permanent missions to the United Nations and other national officials
concerned with the work of the United Nations,
