International assistance for the rehabilitation, reconstruction
and development of the Dominican Republic

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Committee of the Whole of the Economic Commission for Latin America on its thirteenth special session, 1/

Deeply concerned at the magnitude of the damage caused in the Dominican Republic by hurricanes "David" and "Frederic", which resulted in extensive loss of human life and destruction of economic and social infrastructure,

1. Endorses the resolution adopted by the Committee of the Whole of the Economic Commission for Latin America; 2/
2. Urges Governments of Member States and international organizations to provide with the utmost urgency the assistance envisaged in the said resolution for the rehabilitation, reconstruction and development of the Dominican Republic;

3. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Economic and Social Council and the General Assembly informed during the next two years of the results achieved in the implementation of this resolution.
