<u>After</u> paragraph 7 <u>insert</u> a new paragraph 7bis <u>reading</u> In response to the statement by the Executive Secretary, the Chairman of the Administrative Committee, based on interventions by Contracting Parties, concluded that the Contracting Parties to the Convention were concerned about the removal of the TIR Secretary from his post, to which he had been appointed according to a decision by the TIR Administrative Committee (TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/53, para. 29). They did not see any link between the crisis in the TIR system and the removal of the TIR Secretary. The Contracting Parties had expressed great satisfaction with the Secretary. Therefore, the reasons given by the Executive Secretary did not seem to fully clarify the situation.
