CABLE DATED 22 MAY 1965 FROM THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

In accordance Article 54 Charter United Nations I have the honour to transmit to you for information of Security Council following resolution adopted today by Tenth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs:

"At 11.30 p.m. the Teuth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs adopted the following resolution:

"The Tenth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs, Whereas:

At its session on 19 May 1965 the Meeting unanimously resolved to renew the appeal it made to the contending factions in which it called for a cessation of hostilities,

The parties concerned have agreed to a suspension of hostilities for twenty-four hours for humanitarian purposes, and

The Secretary General of the Organization, who was entrusted by the Meeting in its resolution of 20 Mey <u>inter alia</u> with negotiating the strict cease-fire in accordance with the Act of Santo Domingo, is now in Santo Domingo,

Resolves:

- 1. To call upon the parties to transform the suspension of hostilities into a permanent cease-fire, in accordance with the Act of Santo Ecmingo and with the resolution of this Meeting dated 19 May;
- 2. To request the Secretary General of the Organization, representing the Tenth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs, to transmit the text of this resolution to the parties and to do everything possible to achieve its objectives."
