REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF YEMEN TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 8 April 1964 from the Permanent Representative of the Yemen Arab Republic to the United Nations, Mr. Mohsin A. Alaini, stating that he has been authorized by his Government to represent it in the Security Council during the discussion of the complaint by Yemen.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
