IVCRY COAST AND MURCCCO: JOINT DRAFT RESOLUTION

The Security Council,

Having considered the complaint of the Yemen Arab Republic regarding the British air attack on Yemeni Territory on 28 March 1964 (\$/5635);

Deeply concerned at the serious situation prevailing in the eree; <u>Recalling Article 2, peragraphs 3 and 4 of the Charter of the United Nations;</u> <u>Having heard the statements made in the Security Council on this matter:</u>

1. <u>Condemns</u> reprisals as incompatible with the purposes and principles of the United Nations;

2. Deplores the British military action at Harib on 28 March 1964;

3. Deplores all attacks and incidents which have occurred in the area;

4. <u>Calls upon</u> the Yemen Arab Republic and the United Kingdom to exercise the maximum restraint in order to avoid further incidents and to restore peece in the area;

5. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to use his good offices to try to settle outstanding issues, in agreement with the two parties.
