REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY  
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE AND  
ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 30 May 1964 from the Prime Minister and Minister for External Affairs of India stating that Mrs. Lakshmi N. Menon has been appointed representative of India to the Security Council in connexion with the question of apartheid in South Africa and that Mr. Narendra Singh has been appointed alternate representative.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
