Bolivia, Brazil, Ivory Coast, Morocco, Norway: joint draft resolution

The Security Council,

Noting that the report by the Secretary-General (S/5764) considers the maintenance in Cyprus of the United Nations Peace-Keeping Force created by the Security Council resolution of 4 March 1964 (S/5575) for an additional period of three months to be useful and advisable,

Expressing its deep appreciation to the Secretary-General for his efforts in the implementation of the Security Council resolutions of 4 March 1964 and 13 March 1964,

Expressing its deep appreciation to the Member States that have contributed troops, police, supplies and financial support for the implementation of the Security Council resolution of 4 March 1964,

1. Reaffirms its resolutions of 4 March 1964 and 13 March 1964;
2. Takes note of the Report by the Secretary-General (S/5764);
3. Extends the stationing in Cyprus of the United Nations Peace-Keeping Force established under the Security Council resolution of 4 March 1964 for an additional period of three months, ending 26 September 1964 (S/5575).
