LETTER DATED 1 DECEMBER 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my communications of 21, 24 and 26 November 1964, I have the honour to inform you that the rescue operation carried out by my Government in the Stanleyville area has ended.

All the Belgian paracommandos left Kamina on Sunday, 29 November, at 6.30 a.m., after having been assembled there since the evening of Friday, 27 November. They made a stop at Ascension island and returned to Belgium on 1 December.

I should be grateful if you would circulate this communication as a Security Council document.
