LETTER DATED 30 NOVEMBER 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF JORDAN ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Memorandum

The Government of the Hashemite Kingdom has observed and watched with great concern and anxiety the recent grave Israeli unprovoked and unjustified aggression perpetrated against the territory and border of the Syrian Arab Republic. Reliable information has reached the Jordan Government from authoritative sources confirming that the said Israeli aggression was deliberate and premeditated, and, as in previous events, the Government of Jordan views the repeated Israeli attacks against Arab territories as a grave threat to peace in the area and intended to aggravate the situation in the Middle East to serve the Israeli general policy with regard to the Arab States.

The Jordan Government has therefore taken the position of aiding its sister Arab State, the Syrian Arab Republic, in every possible way and shall take the same position in the event that any other Arab sister State becomes subject to such calculated Israeli aggression.

The Jordan Government earnestly hopes that the distinguished members of the Security Council will lend their highly valued support to the Syrian Arab Republic in its complaint in order to ensure a just and lasting peace in the Middle East.
