LETTER DATED 3 DECEMBER 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO (BRAZZAVILLE) ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to inform you that my delegation has been authorized by the Congolese Government to speak at the meeting of the Security Council called to consider the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Therefore, in accordance with rule 37 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council, I should be grateful if you would invite it to sit at the Council table and to participate in the debate, without vote, at such time as you deem appropriate.
