**LETTER DATED 22 SEPTEMBER 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

On the occasion of the continued discussion of Cyprus problem before the Security Council with a view to securing and maintaining peace and tranquillity on the Island pending a political solution, I wish to express my gratitude for the great efforts of United Nations authorities to exert pressure on Greek Cypriots to lift the inhuman economic blockade against Turks as explained fully in your last report to the Council. In particular I wish to express my deep appreciation for your help and for the determined efforts of the Turkish Government in arranging a fact finding enquiry to be made at Kokkina which brought to light and placed before the world public opinion the tragic situation in that area and which eventually resulted in the decision to lift the economic blockade. I hope the same vigilance will be shown so that in future my Community will not be left faced once again with imminent starvation and you will see to it that any attempt to reimpose this inhuman treatment will be foiled effectively in practice.
