LETTER DATED 24 SEPTEMBER 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that my Government has lodged a formal protest with the Turkish Government about the following violation of Greek air space:

On 21 September 1964, at 0950 hours, four Turkish military jet planes flew over the Ypsala area on the Evros river, (40°57 North - 26°20 East) penetrating the border to a depth of 2500 metres.

I would appreciate it if Your Excellency would have this letter reproduced as a document of the Security Council.
