LETTER DATED 8 JANUARY 1965 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THATLAND ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to the letter dated 4 January 1965 of the Permanent Representative of Cambodia to the United Nations circulated as Security Council document 5/6136.

I have now the honour to inform Your Excellency, upon instructions from my Government, that due investigations have been conducted by the Thai authorities into the alleged incidents.

The investigations have firmly establised that no Thai police launch violated the Cambodian waters and that no Cambodian fishermen were abducted by the Thai police as alleged.

I should be grateful if Your Excellency would arrange for this letter to be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
