REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BOLIVIA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 24 November 1964 from the Minister for External Relations of Bolivia, stating that Mr. Fernando Ortiz Sanz had been appointed representative of Bolivia on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
