REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE SITUATION IN
THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Addendum

1. The following information has been received from my Representative in the Dominican Republic since the publication of my last report on the situation there on 15 January 1966 (S/7032/Add.7).
2. Two changes of command took place on 17 January in the Inter-American Peace Force (IAPF). General Hugo Panasco Alvim, of Brazil, transferred the command of the IAPF to General Alvaro Alves Da Silva Braga, also of Brazil. General Bruce Palmer, Jr., handed over the command of the United States Forces in the Dominican Republic to Brigadier-General Robert R. Linvill.
3. General Palmer left the Dominican Republic by air from the San Isidro Air Base on the morning of 17 January. General Alvim was scheduled to leave the country later on the same day.
