B. JUSTIFICATION

These Regulations contain no reference to Annex 5. Initially Annex 5 was introduced by paragraph 20. of the draft proposal (TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/R.288) of GRSG in 1995. However, in its seventieth session, GRSG decided to eliminate all requirements applicable to vehicle door locks, inclusive of paragraph 20. Annex 5 should have been deleted as well. In addition to that, the tests prescribed in Annex 5 are already covered by other requirements of the Regulations, but with different parameters like time, voltages, etc. Maintaining this annex would lead to confusion. As Regulation No. 18 has been used for drafting the new Regulation No. 116, the Netherlands suggest to replace the present text of Annex 5 by "(Reserved)" in both regulations.
