REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PHILIPPINES ON THE SECURITY CCUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 11 February 1963 from the Fermanent Representative of the Philippines to the United Nations, stating that Ambassador Amelito Mutuc and Ambassador Jacquin M. Alizalde have been designated alternate representatives of the Philippines on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
