## Ghana, Morocco, Philippines: joint draft resolution

The Security Council,

Having considered the Secretary-General's report as contained in document S/5443,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 1541 (XV) of 15 December 1960,

Recalling further its resolution contained in document S/5380 of
31 July 1963,

Noting with appreciation the efforts of the Secretary-General in establishing contact between representatives of Portugal and representatives of African States,

- 1. Regrets that this contact has not achieved the desired results, because of failure to reach agreement on the United Nations interpretation of self-determination;
- 2. Calls upon all States to comply with paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution S/5380 of 31 July 1963;
- 3. <u>Deprecates</u> the non-compliance of the Government of Portugal with Security Council resolution S/5380;
- 4. Reaffirms the interpretation of self-determination as laid down in General Assembly resolution 1514 (XV) as follows:

All peoples have the right to self-determination; by virtue of that right they freely determine their political status and freely pursue their economic, social and cultural development;

5. <u>Notes General Assembly resolution 1542 (XV) which enumerated, interalia, territories under Portuguese administration as falling under the category of Mon-Self-Governing Territories within the meaning of Chapter XI of the Charter;</u>

- 6. Believes that action by the Government of Portugal to grant an amnecty to all persons imprisoned or exiled for advocating self-determination in these Territories will be an evidence of its good faith;
- 7. Requests the Secretary-General to continue with his efforts and report to the Council not later than 1 June 1964.
