## INTERIM REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON THE POLICIES OF <u>APARTHEID</u> OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REFUBLIC OF SCUTH AFRICA

Letter dated 6 May 1963 from the Chairman of the Special Committee on the Policies of Apartheid of the Government of the Republic of South Africa, addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to transmit herewith an interim report adopted unanimously on 6 May 1963 by the Special Committee on the Policies of <u>Apartheid</u> of the Government of the Republic of South Africa.

This interim report is submitted in pursuance of operative paragraph 5 (b) of resolution 1761 (XVII), adopted by the General Assembly on 6 November 1962.

The Special Committee considers it highly desirable that the Security Council should consider this report as soon as possible and take the measures called for by the grave situation at present prevailing in the Republic of South Africa, which represents a serious threat to international peace and security.
