REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREMENTALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNALE REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 23 April 1962 from the Prime Minister and Minister for External Affairs of India, stating that Mr. V.K. Krishna Menon. Defence Minister, and Mr. C.S. Jha have been appointed representative and alternate representative of India respectively to participate in meetings of the Security Council on the question of Kashmir.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate credentials.
