REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY  
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA  
TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 3 June 1961 from the Minister of External Affairs of India, stating that Mr. C.S. Jha, Permanent Representative of India to the United Nations, has been authorized to participate on behalf of the Government of India in the meetings of the Security Council on the question of Angola.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate credentials.
