On page two, second paragraph, the second sentence should read as follows:

"The fact that other forces and other States are being drawn into the conflict and that bases close to the Soviet borders are being made available to the aggressive forces is creating a threat to the security of a number of States, including the Soviet Union, a matter which the Soviet Government cannot regard with indifference."
