SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND OF THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that as of 1 December 1962, there has been no change in the matters of which the Security Council is seized or in the stage reached in their consideration since the summary statement covering the week ending 24 November 1962 (S/5209).

During the period covered by this report, the Security Council held its 1026th meeting in private on 30 November 1962 to consider the question of a recommendation for the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations. The Council decided unanimously to recommend to the General Assembly the appointment of U Thant as Secretary-General of the United Nations for a term expiring on 3 November 1966.
