REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF VENEZUELA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 8 September 1960 from the Permanent Representative of Venezuela to the United Nations, stating that he has been appointed by his Government to represent Venezuela at meetings of the Security Council called to consider the item "Letter dated 5 September 1960 from the First Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics addressed to the President of the Security Council".

In the opinion of the Secretary-General this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
