Corrigendum

On page 13, the following paragraph should be inserted between the second and third paragraphs:

"At the 902nd meeting on 15 September, the representative of the United States introduced a draft resolution (S/4516) according to which the Council would, inter alia, urge the Secretary-General to continue to give vigorous effect to its resolutions, call upon Member Governments to make voluntary financial contributions to a United Nations Fund for the Congo, to be used under United Nations control as determined by the Secretary-General, for the financing of the necessary governmental expenditures not covered by governmental revenue owing to the disruption of the administration and civilian life, urge all parties to the internal conflicts within the Republic of the Congo, in the interest of its unity and integrity, to seek a speedy settlement by peaceful means with such assistance from the Secretary-General as might be required, and reaffirm its request to all States to refrain from any action which might tend to impede the restoration of law and order and in particular to refrain from sending personnel, supplies or equipment to be used for military purposes into the Congo other than through the United Nations. At a later meeting, the representative of the United States agreed to a request by Ceylon that a joint draft resolution submitted by Ceylon and Tunisia (S/4523) be given priority in voting, and subsequently stated that he would not press for a vote on the United States draft resolution (S/4516)."
