LETTER DATED 8 DECEMBER 1958 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On behalf of the United States I have the honor to request that you add to the agenda of the Security Council meeting which you have called for Tuesday, 9 December, to consider the admission of new members the following question:

Resolution 1144 A (XII) of the General Assembly adopted
on 25 October 1957.

In view of the finding of the Twelfth General Assembly, in the resolution cited above, that the Republic of Korea is qualified for membership in the United Nations, the United States earnestly hopes that the Security Council will, at its forthcoming meeting, make a favourable recommendation on the application of the Republic of Korea.
