The General Ascembly, havin heard the statement of the renrosentative of Iev Zraland, as thn adoinisterinc Eorer, I/ and hevine examined the relevant cherters of the rerort of tho erocial Correittef on the fituation with roperd to the Implerratation of the Drelaration on the Erantine of Indexerdence to colonial Countries and troples $2 /$ and ondorsin tin conclusions and recomendations contained therein, $3 /$ roffirms the inclimaile rirte of the ceopls cf Tokelau to selfdetorrination and inderendencr in conformity rit the Declaretion on the frantine of Irderendencr to Colonial Countriss ard Foorlss, containod in Fereral Assembly resolution $1514(X V)$ of 14 Dcombre 1960 . Ths renerai Assombly notes that the nolicy of the aur inisterin- Eower will ruided ey the wishes of the poorle of Tokslau concrmine thrir luture rolatiorsile with ore Zealend in full comaliance with
 co-oreration and articularly for its efforts to foster ar increased arareness of the avenues of constitutional dovslorment cren to tho Tokelauans trourh the rrocess of raliticel ducation. Tre Genoral assembly notes the various sters taron in the nonoric and adminiatrative finlas to assist the dovelormont of the Territory and to mrovid an adninistrative instrurent resonsible to the wishrs and nonds of the foovle. The Gomeral Assmmby notos that the adminietorinc Eorer hes essured the sodit ol Tolnlau of its contiruine asoistanop, in the rent that ther desire to

marine resources of the Territory, as well as the affirmation of the administering Power that the benefits therefrom will accrue to the people of the Territory. The General Assembly again expresses its appreciation to the specialized agencies and other organizations within the United Nations system and in particular to the United Nations Development Programme, as, well as to regional organizations, for the assistance which they have rendered to Tokelau and expresses the hope that it will continue. In this connexion, the General Assembly draws the attention of the specialized agencies and other organizations within the United Nations system to the provision of Assembly resolution $31 / 48$ of 1 December 1976 requesting them to consider the methods and scale of their operations and to ensure that they are able to respond appropriately to the requirements of such small and isolated Territories as Tokelau. The General Assembly requests the Special Committee to continue to seeln the best ways and means, in co-operation with the administering Power, of implementing the Declaration with respect to Tokelau, including the possible dispatch of a further visiting mission to the Territory at an aporopriate stare, and to report to the Assembly at its thirty-fifth session on the implementation of the present consensus.
