REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 14 January 1957 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, transmitting a letter signed on 3 January 1957 by the Prime Minister of Pakistan and stating that Malik Firoz Khan Noon, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, has been appointed representative of Pakistan to the Security Council for its meetings on the India-Pakistan question.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these letters constitute adequate provisional credentials.
