Official communiqué of the 5146th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
22 March 2005, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 22 March 2005, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5146th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUC).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. William Lacy Swing, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Major-General Patrick Cammaert, Commander of the Eastern Division and Deputy Force Commander of MONUC, made a statement.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Swing and representatives of participating troop-contributing countries had a constructive exchange of views.”
