QUESTION OF GIBRALTAR

Draft consensus

The General Assembly, noting that since the adoption of its resolution 3286 (XXIX) of 13 December 1974, talks have been held between the Government of Spain and of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and such talks are still continuing, urges both Governments to make possible without delay, taking due account of current circumstances, the initiation of the negotiations envisaged in the consensus adopted by the Assembly on 14 December 1973, 1/with the object of reaching a lasting solution to the problem of Gibraltar, in the light of the relevant resolutions of the Assembly and in the spirit of the Charter of the United Nations.
