#### PLEASARINT HEADQUARTERS COMMITTEE

AMENDED TEXT OF RESCLUTION PROPOSED BY THE UNLITED STATES FOR APPOINTED OF A SUB-COMMUTEEN OF THE HEADQUARTERS COMMUTEE

There is hereby appointed a sub-conmittee consisting of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman, and the Rapporteur of the Headquarters Committee, and representatives of Australia, Belgium, Bolivia, China, Cura, Egypt, France, Iraq, the Natherlands, Poland, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdon, United States of America, Uruguay and Yugoslavia.

The sub-committee with the assistance of the Headquarters Commission shall have the following functions:

- 1. To consider the relative merits of alternative sites for permanent headquarters in the New York area (including the Westchester-Fairfield area), the San Francisco Bay area, the Boston area, and the Philadelphia area, which may be available without cost or at reasonable cost;
- 2. To report to the Headquarters Committee the results of its deliberation together with its specific recommendation as to the site or sites it considers most appropriate, in ample time for debate by the Headquarters Committee and report with recommendation to the General Assembly;
- 3. Take such steps as may be necessary for the effective discharge of the foregoing functions, including the study and inspection of sites under consideration;

- 4. As terms of reference in its work of search of a site for the Permanent Headquarters, the sub-committee will be guided by the following basic United Nations documents in this question:
  - (a) Resolution of the General Assembly of 9 November 1946;
  - (b) Qualifications and standards (PC/ICH/2 of 28 December 1945;
  - (c) Surrary of Requirements of the United Nations (A/HQC/W.20/Rev.2 of 1 July 1946)

The sub-committee will also make use in its work of the experience of the United Nations Inspection Group document A/SITE/2 of 4 February 1946 and that of the Headquarters Commission document A/69.
