Emissions projections of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of the report on the workshop on emission projections from Parties included in Annex I to the Convention (Annex I Parties) (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/INF.15). The SBSTA noted with appreciation the support provided for the workshop by the Government of Germany through the Bonn Fund.
- 2. The SBSTA noted that the report contains useful information on methodological and reporting issues relating to greenhouse gas (GHG) projections and on experiences in dealing with general and cross-cutting aspects of GHG projections, and also addresses specific issues relating to all sectors (energy, transport, industry, agriculture, land use, land-use change and forestry, and waste). It encouraged Annex I Parties to take this information into consideration when they prepare their next national communications in order to further enhance the transparency of reporting on projections.
