

Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2004, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-ninth session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/59/L.68

- 2. At its 57th meeting, on 8 June 2005, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola" (A/C.5/59/L.68), which was submitted by the Chairman on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Singapore.
- 3. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/59/L.68 without a vote (see para. 4).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola

The General Assembly

- (a) Decides that updated information on the financial position of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola should be included in the report to be considered by the Assembly at its sixtieth session on the updated financial position of closed peacekeeping missions, under the agenda item entitled "Administrative and budgetary aspects of the financing of the United Nations peacekeeping operations";
- (b) Also decides that the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola" shall be eliminated from the agenda.
