RESOLUTION NO. 7 - N.D.-1

## A RESOLUTION

Inviting the United Nations Security Council and the United Nations Trusteeship Council to observe the Political Education Program.

WHEREAS, the Cabinet has established a Political Education Program to inform the people of the Marshall Islands concerning the compact of free association between the Republic and the United States of America, and for that purpose has established a Commission on Political Education; and

WHEREAS, for such a programme to successfully brief the people in such a way that they can make a free and informed choice on the compact it is necessary that the programme not only be effective but also be, and be seen to be, impartial; and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness and impartiality of the programme is a matter that concerns both the people of the Marshall Islands and also the United Nations, and through the United Nations the nations of the world; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore the considered and firm opinion of the  $\underline{\text{Nitijela}}$  that it would be desirable for the programme to be officially observed by the United Nations; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the people of the Marshall Islands, through their <u>Nitijela</u> in its fourth constitutional regular session, 1983, that the Cabinet be requested, and it is hereby requested, to invite the United Nations Security Council and the United Nations Trusteeship Council to send observers to see the Political Education Program in action; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker send a certified copy of this resolution to the United States, the United Nations Security Council and the United Nations Trusteeship Council.
