## **Human settlements**


The Economic and Social Council, recalling its relevant resolutions on the coordinated implementation of the Habitat Agenda,<sup>1</sup>

(a) Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General on the coordinated implementation of the Habitat Agenda;<sup>2</sup>

(b) Decides to transmit the report to the General Assembly for consideration at its sixtieth session;

(c) Requests the Secretary-General to submit a report on the coordinated implementation of the Habitat Agenda for consideration by the Council at its substantive session of 2006.
