United Nations Development Fund for Women

The Economic and Social Council,

Recognizing that mainstreaming a gender perspective into all aspects of the work of the United Nations is an ongoing process and that further concrete steps are required, as a matter of urgency, to ensure full implementation of its agreed conclusions 1997/2 and its resolution 2004/4 of 7 July 2004,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 59/250 of 22 December 2004, in which the Assembly called upon the United Nations development system to avail itself of the technical experience of the United Nations Development Fund for Women on gender issues,

1. *Welcomes* the report of the Consultative Committee of the United Nations Development Fund for Women on the current status and future role and structure of the Fund in the United Nations system;¹
2. *Recommends* that the General Assembly examine and take action on the recommendations of the Consultative Committee contained in its report.
