Letter dated 25 July 2005 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my predecessor's letter of 23 February 2004 (S/2004/157), transmitting a fourth report from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).

The Counter-Terrorism Committee has considered the report carefully, with the assistance of its experts, and has written to the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations to set out its preliminary comments.
