## Addendum

- 1. Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that since the issuance of his reports dated 30 December 1976 and 10 January 1977 with regard to the representation of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 1977-1978, he has received the following additional communications:
- 2. <u>India</u>. The Secretary-General has received a letter dated 8 January 1977 from the Permanent Representative of India to the United Nations stating that Mr. Saad Hashmi has been appointed deputy representative of India on the Security Council, and Mr. Ramesh N. Mulye, Mr. Sushil Dubey, Mr. G. S. Iyer and Mr. Shashank alternate representatives.
- 3. <u>Mauritius</u>. The Secretary-General has received a letter dated 14 January 1977 from the Permanent Representative of Mauritius to the United Nations stating that Mr. Parrwiz Cassim Hossen has been appointed alternate representative of Mauritius on the Security Council.
- 4. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these letters constitute adequate provisional credentials.
