Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo

Note verbale dated 18 August 2005 from the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo and, with reference to his note verbale of 11 May 2005, has the honour to inform the Committee that the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil has adopted the necessary measures, in compliance with the sanctions regime established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1596 (2005).

Security Council resolution 1596 (2005) was incorporated into national legislation by decree 5489 of 13 July 2005. In keeping with that decree, the Brazilian authorities must comply, within the limits of their duties and powers, with the provisions of Security Council resolution 1596 (2005) including those related to the arms embargo, assets freeze and travel ban.
