  - D and E. Please provide a website or other sources (e.g., documents) containing further information and explain the links in relation to the overall WSIS process and other contexts;
  - F, G, H, I and J. Please indicate the geographical coverage, the timescale, the activity type, the main partners involved and the approximate financial commitment.
- 4. Your commitments will be posted on the WSIS website, and in the "Golden Book" that will be released in the first quarter of 2006. We would also welcome future updates to this information.
