

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1521 (2003) concerning Liberia

Note verbale dated 16 September 2005 from the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1521 (2003) concerning Liberia, and has the honour to inform the Committee that Security Council resolution 1607 (2005) was incorporated into national legislation by Decree No. 5529 of 2 September 2005.

In accordance with paragraph 1 of the adopted legislation, Brazilian authorities are required to implement, within their respective areas of responsibility, the provisions of resolution 1607 (2005), by which, among other things, the Security Council renewed the measures on diamonds imposed by paragraph 6 of resolution 1521 (2003) for a further period of six months.
