**Security Council Committee established

**Note verbale dated 28 September 2005 from the Permanent
Mission of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman
of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo. It has the honour to inform the Committee that the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil has adopted the necessary measures, in compliance with Security Council resolution 1616 (2005), by which the Council renewed, among other measures, the arms embargo in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Security Council resolution 1616 (2005) was incorporated into national legislation by Decree No. 5548 of 22 September 2005. In keeping with that decree, the Brazilian authorities must comply, within the limits of their duties and powers, with the provisions related to the arms embargo, asset freeze and travel ban.
