Annex C

EXTRACT FROM THE PENAL CODE

Incitation to hatred

Article 283

1. Any person who, in public and in a manner likely to create a breach of the peace, urges or incites any other person to commit a hostile act against a church or a religious community duly established in the country, against a group belonging to such church or religious community, or against a race, nation, tribe or State, shall be punished by imprisonment for a maximum period of one year.

2. Any person who in public and in a manner prejudicial to human dignity, incites hatred against, insults or seeks to defame any of the groups referred to in paragraph 1 shall be punished in the same manner.
