Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. In connexion with the information contained in paragraphs 1 and 6 and annex I of document E/CN.4/1231 concerning ratifications of, and accessions to, the International Convention on the Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of Apartheid, it should be added that the instruments of accession to the Convention by the Governments of Tunisia and Cuba were deposited with the Secretary-General on 21 January 1977 and 1 February 1977, respectively. In accordance with the provisions of its article XV, paragraph 2, the Convention will enter into force for Tunisia on 20 February 1977 and for Cuba on 3 March 1977.

2. As of 3 March 1977, therefore, there will be 25 States parties to the Convention, including the following eight States, which are also members of the Commission on Human Rights as presently constituted:

Cuba
Ecuador
Libyan Arab Republic
Syrian Arab Republic
Union of Soviet Socialist Republics
Yugoslavia.
