

Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: confirmation of the appointment of members of the Investments Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 17th plenary meeting, on 20 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixtieth session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: confirmation of the appointment of members of the Investments Committee".
- 2. At its 20th meeting, on 3 November 2005, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning vacancies in the membership of the Investments Committee that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of three of its members on 31 December 2005 (A/60/103);
- (b) Note by the Secretary-General in which, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General, after consultation with the Standing Committee of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submitted for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of three persons as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2006 (A/C.5/60/6).
- 3. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it confirm the appointment of Madhav Dhar (India), Nemir A. Kirdar (Iraq) and Masakazu Arikawa (Japan) as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2006 (see para. 4).

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of the following persons as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2006:

Madhav Dhar (India) Nemir A. Kirdar (Iraq) Masakazu Arikawa (Japan)
