## Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

### Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2005/15 of 25 February 2005, S/2005/15/Add.20 of 31 May 2005, S/2005/15/Add.21 of 7 June 2005, S/2005/15/Add.27 of 19 July 2005, S/2005/15/Add.29 of 3 August 2005, S/2005/15/Add.36 of 20 September 2005 and S/2005/15/Add.37 of 27 September 2005.

During the week ending 15 October 2005, the Security Council took action on the following items:

**Reports of the Secretary-General on the Sudan** (*see* S/2004/20/Add.23, 30, 35, 37, 39, 40, 44, 46 and 49; and S/2005/15/Add.1, 4-6, 9-12, 18, 25, 28, 30 and 37; *see also* S/2003/40/Add.40; S/2004/20/Add.21 and 43; and S/2005/15/Add.37)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5277th meeting, held on 13 October 2005 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, *see* S/PRST/2005/48; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2005-31 July 2006*).

**The situation in Côte d'Ivoire** (*see* S/2002/30/Add.50; S/2003/40/Add.5, 17, 19, 29, 31, 45, 47 and 48; S/2004/20/Add.5, 8, 17, 21, 31, 44, 46 and 50; and S/2005/15/Add.4, 12, 13, 16, 17, 21, 24, 26 and 34; *see also* S/2003/40/Add.44; S/2004/20/Add.12; and S/2005/15/Add.11)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5278th and 5279th (private) meetings, held on 13 October 2005, and at its 5281st meeting, held on 14 October 2005, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the 5278th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to the representative of Nigeria to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Côte d'Ivoire, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Said Djinnit, Commissioner of the African Union Commission; Pierre Schori, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Côte d'Ivoire; and António Monteiro, High Representative of the Secretary-General for the elections in Côte d'Ivoire.

At the close of the 5279th meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5279th meeting, held in private on 13 October 2005, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Côte d'Ivoire’.

“The President recalled the invitation extended under rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Oluyemi Adeniji, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Nigeria, as well as invitations extended under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Said Djinnit, Commissioner of the African Union Commission, Pierre Schori, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Côte d'Ivoire, and António Monteiro, High Representative of the Secretary-General for the elections in Côte d'Ivoire.

“Members of the Council exchanged views with the aforementioned invitees.”

At the 5281st meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Côte d'Ivoire, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2005/49; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2005-31 July 2006*).

**The situation in Somalia** (see S/23370/Add.11, 16, 30, 34 and 48; S/25070/Add.12, 23, 38, 43 and 46; S/1994/20/Add.4, 21, 33, 38 and 43; S/1995/40/Add.13; S/1996/15/Add.3, 10 and 50; S/1997/40/Add.8, 16 and 51; S/1999/25/Add.20 and 44; S/2000/40/Add.25 and 36; S/2001/15/Add.2, 25, 42 and 44; S/2002/30/Add.10, 12, 17, 26, 29 and 49; S/2003/40/Add.10, 14, 45 and 50; S/2004/20/Add.8, 28, 33, 43 and 46; and S/2005/15/Add.9, 10 and 27; see also S/23370/Add.3)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5280th meeting, held on 14 October 2005 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it a letter dated 5 October 2005 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751

(1992) concerning Somalia addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2005/625).

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2005/646) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2005/646, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1630 (2005) (for the text, see S/RES/1630 (2005); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2005-31 July 2006*).
