## Amend paragraph 18 to read:

- 18. In accordance with paragraph 4 of Article 13 of the Protocol, the Conference had before it national annual reports from the following 51 States <sup>1</sup>: Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bangladesh, Belarus, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Guatemala, Holy See, Hungary, India, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Morocco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Pakistan, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Senegal, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and United States of America. The reports contained information on:
  - (a) dissemination of information on the Protocol to armed forces and to the civilian populations;
  - (b) mine clearance and rehabilitation programmes;
  - (c) steps taken to meet technical requirements of the Protocol and any other relevant information pertaining thereto;
  - (d) legislation related to the Protocol;
  - (e) measures taken on international technical information exchange, on international cooperation on mine clearance, and on technical cooperation and assistance;
  - (f) other relevant matters; and
  - (g) information provided to the database on mine clearance established within the United Nations System.
